Year 1 Criteria																			
1	Can write their own name with appropriate upper and lower case letters																		
2	Can form all letters, although shape and size may be irregular																		
3	Writes simple regular words, some spelt correctly																		
4	Almost always leaves spaces between words																		
5	Make sensible phonic attempts at words																		
6	Can spell CVC words correctly																		
7	Confidently writes some caption, labels and attempts other forms of writing																		
8	Can show some control over the letter size, shape and orientation in writing																		
9	Can say what their writing means																		
10	Can retell known stories in writing																		
11	Can produce their own ideas for their writing																		
12	Can show some control over word order, producing logical statements																		
13	Can spell most Year R and 1 High frequency words and Year 1 National curriculum words																		
14	Can make recognizable attempts at spellings not known																		
15	Can write simple text such as lists, reports, recounts or a paragraph or more																		
16	Begin to show an awareness of full stops																		
17	Can usually give letters a clear and regular size, shape and orientation																		
18	Can use ANY conjunction (and) to join two simple sentences																		
19	Can use appropriate vocab in more than three statements																		
20	Can always use logical phonic strategies when trying to spell unknown words in more than three statements																		
21	Can usually use a capital letter and full stop, question mark or exclamation mark to punctuate sentences																		
22	Can produce a paragraph or more of developed ideas independently that can be read without help from the child
