R.E.- In R.E. this term, we will be looking at how the Holy Spirit has inspired Christians. We will also be thinking about people who inspire us. In term 6, we will be exploring the question 'What's best for our world?'

Art and Design- In D.T. this term, children will be continuing with their Wind in the Willows animations. They will be learning how to film a smooth animation and will develop their understanding of how to edit a film.

MATHS

COMPUTING

In term 5, children will be focussing on e-safety, and they will be using various forms of technology to create and share ideas for staying safe when online.

During term 6, children will be revisiting programming, learning about algorithms and exploring programs such as Scratch.

Year 5 Computing lessons will be led by Mrs Holt.

LITERACY

Literacy Hour this term will cover explanation and report writing. Next term, we will further explore poetry, focusing on rap. We will also be completing fact files and writing letters.

Reading - We would appreciate your continued support in ensuring your child reads regularly. You can also help by asking your child questions about the text being read.

In year 5, children are expected to read four times a week. Reading is checked on Friday for both classes.

SCIENCE

The Science programme for term 5 is 'Earth and Space'. Within this we will look at the scale of space, the planets within it and

how the Earth, sun and moon orbit.

After half term, we will be exploring 'Forces'. We will be labelling forces on diagrams and completing investigations.
