This week we are writing a story about a passenger who survives the Titanic.

Your child will need to write in the 3rd person.

Their story will start with the main character standing on the docks ready to embark on their voyage. The next part of the story will include boarding the ship and seeing/listening to/smelling all the wonderful things on board

i.e. the cabins/staircase/facilities.

They will then go on to writing about what happened to their character as they enjoyed the voyage and what occurred during the crash.

Children will need to use a range of punctuation, interesting words (adjectives) and phrases that we have identified in Literacy this week
