

Wednesday Talk Homework in preparation for Thursday's BIG WRITE

The children will be writing captions about the story Jack and the Beanstalk.

You may want to:

1. Read different versions of the story
2. Discuss what happens during the story
3. Model a sentence verbally for different parts of the story related to the pictures.
4. Discuss what we need at the beginning and end of a sentence.
5. Practise writing words linked to the story carefully on a line.

We will be looking for the children to be writing in clear sentences with a starting capital letter, finger spaces and full stops. Their handwriting should be neat with all letters correctly formed and ascenders and descenders standing taller or hanging below the other letters. They should be beginning to extend their sentences using 'and, because, so' to connect ideas together and include more detail in their ideas.
