- Homework out

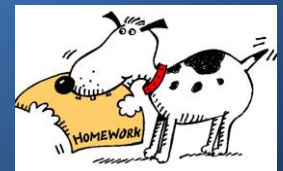

- Children will be given Maths and Literacy homework each week.
- Maths - 2 tasks on Mathletics (please encourage children to show their working out!) and a times-table sheet. If your child completes all of their Mathletics homework on time, in one term, they will be entered into a class raffle to win the Maths Whizz treat.
- Literacy - comprehension and/or a GPS sheet. The children may be given half-term projects to complete.
- In order to make the children become more independent and ready for secondary school, your child will miss their break-time, to begin to understand the importance of deadlines.



Reading Record Books

- Expectation for your child to read at least 4 times a week.
- Children that have four parent signatures recorded in their book will be entered into the class raffle on a Monday.
- If children are consistently not reading 4 times a week (do not have 4 signatures), children will miss part/all of their Monday break-time to read.
- If your child reads more than 50 times in the term, they will be entered into a class raffle and one child will be selected to take part in the Reading champion treat.

P.E
