- Mathematics – Have a go at both live Mathematics as well as weekly homework activities that are uploaded every Thursday. I can see how many points you have earned and there is a class competition with prizes at the end of each term.
- TT Rockstars – There will be regular battles set up between the year 4 classes. We also recommend regular visits to ‘Soundcheck’ which is a 25 question test that is similar to the summer assessment your child will be undertaking.
- Daily reading at home – remember you don’t have to read just your normal reading book, try a newspaper, webpage or comic (if you can get hold of one) also online books are good.
- Weekly spelling lists – please practise these! (Look, say, cover, write, check). If you miss the weekly Thursday test, try a test at home.

Please can you create a research project about different rivers from around the world. After half term, try researching Ancient Egypt and what life was like for the people who lived during this time.
