SCHOOL MEALS: After Easter the school kitchen will be serving meals from the new menu which was sent to you by Parent Mail last week (available on the school website). Please remember that all meals for week commencing Monday 19th April 2021 will need to be booked by no later than Thursday 15th April 2021. This includes Universal Free School Meals which do not incur a charge. When making your bookings please consider booking for the whole term if you can. If you have not booked meals for your child/children, please ensure that they are sent to school with a packed lunch.
