Covid-19 'Catch up' Funding

The government announced £1 billion of funding to support children and young people to catch up lost time after school closure. This is especially important for the most vulnerable and disadvantaged backgrounds.

School allocations will be calculated on a per pupil basis. Mainstream school will get £80 for each pupil in from reception to year 11 inclusive.

Schools will get funding in 3 tranches during the 2020 – 2021 academic year and King's Meadow School will receive £32,000. The spending of this funding will be linked to the School Development Plan Priority - The Recovery Programme Plan

The aim of this priority is to 'Provide a Covid 19 recovery programme to minimise loss of academic knowledge and mental/physical wellbeing that may have occurred during the national pandemic'.

Spending:

- The 2020-2021 Covid-19 'Catch Up' funding will be used to employ a class teacher for a one year period.
