R.E. - In R.E., the children will explore different Christian views about Inspiration and think about who inspires them.

MATHS

In Maths, children will be developing their understanding of calculating space and mathematical movement. They will also be learning more about time and data and we will be recapping on fractions, decimals and percentages.

It is particularly important that all of the children are confident with their times tables and have instant re-call. We would be grateful if you could support our efforts in school by practising tables with your children at home.



COMPUTING

The children will become artists online using different mediums on the computer. We will also be reinforcing the importance of staying safe online.

LITERACY

Literacy hour this term will be looking at Reports. We have chosen to look at newspaper reports. We will also be looking at discussion texts and enhancing our understanding of SPAG.

Reading - We would appreciate your continued support in ensuring your child reads regularly. You can also help by asking your child questions about the text being read.

In Year 5, children are expected to read four times a week. Reading will be checked every Friday for both classes.

SCIENCE

In term 5, our topic will be 'Living Things and their Habitats'. We will be learning how plants reproduce and will compare the life cycles of amphibians and insects.

In Term 6, we will be investigating Animals including Humans. The children will be able to describe the stages of human development and learn more about puberty. Look out for more information on this during term 6.
