



Houses and Homes

There are lots of different types of houses and homes that people can live in.

Terraced Houses

Terraced houses are a line of three or more houses all joined together.



Semi-detached Houses

A semi-detached house means two houses are joined together on one side.



Detached Houses

A detached house is not joined to the house next door.



Bungalows

A bungalow is a building where all the rooms are on ground level. There are no stairs.



Flats and Apartments

These are larger buildings split into lots of homes. Sometimes they are very tall.



Not everyone lives in a building. Sometimes people live in caravans or even on boats.
