The School agrees to:

The Parents/Guardians agree to:

- Make sure that my child arrives in school on time and is collected on time.
- Make sure that my child attends the school regularly and inform the school of the reasons for any absence as soon as possible.
- Support the school in maintaining my child's good behaviour and discipline.
- Support my child with homework and other home learning opportunities and listen to my child read.
- Attend open evenings and the parent / teacher meetings.
- Ensure that my child wears the school uniform and follows the school dress code.
- Let the school know if there are any problems that may affect my child's ability to learn.

The Pupil agrees to :

- Come to school regularly and be on time.
- Work hard and listen carefully to instructions.
- Keep the class/school rules and behave well.
- Respect and care for other people.
- Be helpful, friendly and polite to other children and all adults.
- Walk whilst inside the building and take care outside.
- Wear the school uniform and follow the dress code.
- Work hard and do my best with classwork and homework.
- Take good care of the school environment and buildings.
- Take care of the equipment.

Together we will:

- Celebrate the child's efforts and achievements
- Encourage the children to keep the school and class rules.
- Support children's learning at school and home to help them enjoy learning and to achieve their best.
- Support children with special needs.
- Help the child to benefit from and enjoy their experiences and time in school.
- Help the child to take pride in their own efforts and achievements in King's Meadow School.
